On behalf of our entire staff, I would like to officially welcome you and your child back to Franklin High School. I am sending this letter to help ensure everyone marks the calendar with the important upcoming dates for the new school year.

Pink Emergency Cards and other Start-of-School forms: Wednesday, August 15th & Thursday, August 16th

On August 15th and 16th from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m., students can pick up their back-to-school packets in the Main Office. Inside this packet, you will find a pink emergency card. Please be sure to check the accuracy of the information, making any necessary changes on the card. You will need to sign only the bottom of the emergency card. Besides the emergency card, please be sure to review the following: *Patriotically Speaking* newsletter, Concussion Fact Sheet, LPS Student LivNet Access Policy form, and the Student Handbook.

*Students who will be graduating with the Class of 2019 will also need to turn in the Diploma Certificate and the Release of Records forms.

Schedule Pick-Up: Thursday, August 23 & Friday, August 24th

Provided they bring in their pink emergency card form signed, students may stop by Franklin on Thursday, August 23rd or on Friday, August 24th to pick up a paper-copy of their class schedule. On Thursday, schedules will be available for pick up in the Main Office from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. and from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. On Friday, schedules will be available for pick up in the Main Office from 8 am. to 3 p.m. Paper copies of class schedules will also be available for pick up on Monday, August 27th and Thursday, August 30th from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. in the Main Office.

The First Day of School: Tuesday, September 4th

On September 4th, only ninth grade students who are starting their first year at Franklin are to report for a Ninth Grade Orientation (with lunch) at the regular school start time of 7:25 a.m. On September 4th, after Freshmen Orientation, all students (9th, 10th, 11th, and 12th graders) will experience an abbreviated day of classes ending with our regular dismissal time of 2:20 p.m.
